

HEALTH AND SAFETY MEASURES: **RETURNING TO SCHOOL**



Safety First – Health Screening

- **Passive Monitoring – Self Screening**
Students, staff, and visitors will be asked to monitor their own temperatures and symptoms – and will be asked to stay home if demonstrating COVID symptoms or have temperature of 100.4 or greater degrees
- **Active Monitoring – At School**
 - Students, staff, and visitors will be screened for symptoms upon arrival at the school including a temperature check with a non-contact thermometer. Those with temperatures of 100.4 degrees or greater will be sent home. Students will wait in isolation area until parent/guardian can transport home.
- **Hand washing faucets and sanitizers in classrooms and sanitizer dispensers throughout campus.**
- **Face masks issued and required of staff and students**
- **Social Distancing (6' or more) will be required**
- **Drinking fountains closed. Send your child with a water bottle.**
- **COVID-19 Awareness and Prevention course for all staff**
- **CDC posters and educational signage throughout campus and in restrooms**

HEALTH AND SAFETY MEASURES:

CLASSROOMS

- **Classroom Configuration (960 sq. ft.)**
 - Will hold up to 16 desks (6' radius)
 - Allows for social distancing entering and exiting the classroom
- **Wall mounted hand sanitizer at entry door**
- **Pump hand sanitizer on teacher desks**
- **Students and staff required to wear face masks**
 - All staff and students will be issued 2 personal cloth masks and additional disposable masks will be available in classrooms
- **Full PPE (including face shields) available to faculty and students**
- **HVAC filtration improvements (next slide)**

HEALTH AND SAFETY MEASURES:

CLEANING AND DISINFECTING

Each Campus will be Cleaned and Disinfected Every Evening

- **19 custodians district-wide**
- **13 sub custodians**
- **All student desks, teacher desk, and frequently touched areas (doorknobs, whiteboards, light switches, etc.) will be cleaned and disinfected**
- **Hand sanitizer will be replenished**
- **Restrooms will be disinfected multiple times during the day**
- **Addition of ONE electro-static sprayers at each site to assist with nightly disinfection of all surfaces**

Spray disinfectant available to faculty and staff

HEALTH AND SAFETY MEASURES:

TRANSPORTATION

- **Student capacity will be reduced to maintain physical distancing**
- **Students (and bus drivers) will be required to wear face masks**
- **Hand sanitizer available on all buses**
- **Students will be seated from the rear of the bus forward to minimize passing**
- **Windows will be opened if weather permits**
- **Buses will be cleaned and disinfected**



HEALTH AND SAFETY MEASURES:

NUTRITION SERVICES

- **Nutrition service staff wear face coverings in kitchen and serving lines**
- **Grab and Go: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner**
- **Gloves are worn**
- **Outdoor spaces will be utilized for dispersing meals.**
- **Touchless hand sanitizer stations at each serving line**
- **Physical distancing will be required while students are in line and while eating**
- **Quick serve pre-packaged meals will be served**
- **Meals will be provided for students at home on distance learning days**



Plan for When Someone Gets Sick

**RESPONSE
TO COVID-
19 CASES**

- **Immediate Action**
- **Isolate student/employee until they can be transported home or to a healthcare facility**
 - Conduct assessment to determine persons/facilities with risk of exposure
 - Close off area(s) until cleaning and disinfecting can be completed
 - Advise those who have been in contact to self quarantine for 14 days, monitor symptoms, and test if necessary (respond case by case)
 - Clean and disinfect facilities with risk exposure
 - Work with Kern County Public Health on tracing, communication with the public, and possible school closure
